

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## UK Parliamentary election

### For the Daventry constituency

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve the Daventry Constituency.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Acting Returning Officer, at the Council Offices, Lodge Road, Daventry, Northamptonshire, NN11 4FP.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer at the Council Offices, Lodge Road, Daventry, Northamptonshire, NN11 4FP on any day after the date of this notice, between Monday and Friday 10 am to 4 pm (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4pm on Thursday 9 April 2015.
4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on 7 May 2015.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday 20 April 2015.
6. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Lodge Road, Daventry, Northamptonshire, NN11 4FP by 5 pm on Tuesday 21 April 2015.
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Lodge Road, Daventry, Northamptonshire, NN11 4FP by 5 pm on Tuesday 28 April 2015.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Lodge Road, Daventry, Northamptonshire, NN11 4FP by 5 pm on 7 May 2015. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Tuesday 28 April 2015. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Tuesday 28 April 2015.
