18/ 4180 Mercedes AMG Performance Powertrains – Site Minutes of the Previous Meeting (24th May 2018)

Adam Allsopp and Richard Stevens of Mercedes AMG High Performance Powertrains presented the vision for the continued development of the Mercedes site within Brixworth.

The site was to be developed in stages over several years. Stages 1 and 2 were already underway. In the short term it was proposed to construct a staff welfare facility to provide a gymnasium and studio. This was to aid staff retention. A single storey extension was also planned together with the retention of a modular building which was serving a limited life project. Further planned improvements include the installation of solar panels together with ongoing landscaping of the site. Mercedes remained committed to improve the aesthetics of the site. Longer term there are

plans for both a manufacturing facility and a car park deck.

Parish Councillors discussed the traffic issues arising from the site. The Parish Council noted Mercedes ongoing commitment to the Brixworth site and encouraged Mercedes to engage with the community through a variety of ways.

The Chairman thanked both Mr Allsopp and Mr Stevens for updating the Parish Council on the development proposals.


